Not following all items will void your warranty

- 1. Blow all lines out to remove foreign matter
- 2. Change all filters
- 3. Check/Change Garlock seal if leaking
- 4. Check for Oil leaks
- 5. **DO NOT** use Teflon Tape or sealant of any kind
- 6. **DO NOT** disassemble pump
- 7. Cover unit when cleaning engine with any solvent
- 8. Check all lines for dry rot and damage
- 9. Complete warranty registration card, return immediately

If within such period, any such replacement parts shall be proved to Rapco's satisfaction to be defective, such replacement parts shall be replaced, or the purchase price refunded at Rapco's sole option. The customer's exclusive remedy and Rapco's sole obligation hereunder shall be limited to such replacement, F.O.B. Rapco's factory, or to refund of the purchase price, and shall be conditioned upon Rapco's receiving written notice of any alleged defects within thirty (30) days after its discovery, and at Rapco's option, return of such products prepaid to its factory. This warranty shall not apply or extend to any parts that have not been replaced in connection with reconditioning or rebuilding or products by Rapco or to replacement parts repaired or altered by others that Rapco so as in its judgment adversely to effect the same, or to replacement parts that were subject to negligence, accident, damages by circumstances beyond Rapco's control, to improper installation (if by others than Rapco), operation, maintenance or storage, or to other than normal use or service. Further, as to any parts that have not been replaced in connection with reconditioning or rebuilding or products by Rapco, Rapco, not being the manufacturer of any such parts nor the manufacturer's agent, makes no express or implied warranties or representations of any kind as to any matter whatsoever, including, without limitation, condition, design, quality or capacity of any such parts, merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose of any such parts with the requirement of any law, rule, specification or contract pertaining thereto.

THE FORGOING WARRANTIES ARE IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER EXPRESS WARRANTIES (EXCEPT WRITTEN WARRANTIES SPECIFICALLY LABELED AS "WARRANTIES OR GUARANTIES" AND FURNISHED BY RAPCO) AND ARE IN LIEU OF ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. WARRANTY PERIOD

New Dry Air Pumps*

RAP215CC series, RAP216CW 3 years, 1300 hours from date of installation or 4 years from date of manufacture whichever comes first.
RAP241CC series, RAP242CW series 1 year, 500 hours from date of installation or 4 years from date of manufacture whichever comes first.
RAP441CC series, RAP442CW series 1 year, 500 hours from date of installation or 4 years from date of manufacture whichever comes first.

Overhaul Dry Air Pumps*

211CC series, 212CW, 215CC, 216CW 2 years, 1000 hours from date of installation or 4 years from date of overhaul whichever comes first.
241CC series, 242CW series 1 year, 400 hours from date of installation or 4 years from date of overhaul whichever comes first.
441CC series, 442CW series 1 year, 400 hours from date of installation or 4 years from date of overhaul whichever comes first.

*For a dry air pump warranty to be valid the Warranty Registration card must be completely filled out and returned to Rapco. Alternately, the pump may be registered on the Rapco web site - www.rapcoinc.com after unit installation. For warranty consideration: the Customer Warranty Record must be completely filled out and returned with the defective unit to the distributor from which it was purchased.
